

Dudu. The Official Core Beliefs, Tenets and Code of Ifa



We believe in one Supreme God.

We believe Nyeungana is a message from God, it's an order from God on how to carry out God's will, It's the only route to eternal salvation.

Living by Nyeungana is a way of worshipping and obeying/honouring God. A way of fulfilling God's will.

We believe the tenet of Ifa Dudu was provided by God.

God, the supreme being and energy is the creator of the world.

God is Love.

God loves everyone and recognises the validity of all God's messengers who have endeavoured to make the world a better place during their times (messengers such as those within Ifa, Christianity, Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, Judaism, Sikhism, Rastafarianism); hence God expects the same from us.

It's part of God's plan for the world for the Nyeungana vision to be realised and continued to be maintained, forever.

In order to be closer to God, you need to be the embodiment of the Nyeungana vision.

God wants us to achieve the highest position of wellbeing in our lifetime and work toward achieving the same for our offspring. This is both physically (e.g., health and the protection of our wellbeing) and mentally (e.g., financially, legally, family life and general mental health) wellbeing. As a result, we have to ensure we put ourselves in the situation that God wants for us and live a moral life. This is all to ensure the highest form of our wellbeing.

Relationship with God: Giving Honour & Grace to God

Aside from abiding with the tenet and code our followers are urged to:

Make sacrifices (selfless charitable deeds), that will help realize the Nyeungana vision.

Study the scriptures ensuring to interpret them through the lens of Nyeungana; Personally, or when possible within a group of other Ifa Dudu followers.

Pray: It's considered preferable to end any form of communication with God with the word 'Ase'.

If a follower has a need that requires extra guidance or wants to give extra glory to God then, they are free to consult an ordained person within the Ifa Dudu religion.

The Vision & Message: Nyeungana

Imagine a tomorrow where all black people are forever united across physical geographic borders in their fight against poverty, marginalisation, injustice, discrimination and any other form of oppression.
